**The Epsom, Ewell & District Centre** has raised £59,050 in the period 2003-2015 covering 91 National Trust projects across 31 properties. This was achieved largely by arranging a varied programme of social events, coach outings and illustrated lectures and talks.

**Evening Lectures** are held at Bourne Hall, Ewell every month except January & August. We are fortunate in being able to attract some knowledgeable and entertaining speakers who illustrate their subjects either by computer-generated photographs or slides. The Lectures and Talks are on a wide range of topics such as Treasures of the Nile, The Art of the Folly, Seen from my Bicycle and Careless Talks Cost Lives.

The coach outing programme takes members to historic houses and gardens (not necessarily National Trust properties) and visits have included Bletchley Park, the Olympic Site, Savill Garden in Windsor Great Park, Essex Smuggling Haunts and Hatfield House. We also arrange other more local trips such as visiting The Magic Circle, Trooping the Colour, a backstage tour of The Royal Opera House in Covent Garden and the Ceremony of the Keys at the Tower of London.

**Our Walks programme** usually explores some aspects of London e.g. Georgian London, Dickens' London, Palaces and the Lambeth Walk. It is perhaps not surprising that we have found there is so much of interest in London especially with a guide.

**Other Special events** include Coffee Mornings, Holidays and Christmas Lunch, Lunches and Quiz Nights.

**Newsletters** are produced four times a year, which give details of forthcoming events and include application forms for the events.
